# Information for parents – September 2024

We are based at Glazebrook Methodist Church, Glazebrook Lane, Warrington, WA3 5AY, where we offer a homely, welcoming and rural environment where children learn through play. We have regular family sessions, outings and coffee mornings, where the whole family can experience life at Pre-School.

# Opening times (term time only):

Morning sessions 8.50 to 11.50

Full day sessions

8.50 to 2.50

Children can attend either for the morning or for the full day and for a minimum of 2 sessions per week. Your child can start any time following their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday.

We work in close partnership with parents and can offer flexible hours to meet the needs of your child.

From the term following your child's 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday, Warrington Borough Council provides funding for a maximum number of hours each year. In certain circumstances Warrington Borough Council also provides funding from the term following a child reaching 9 months old. Please speak to a member of staff to check how much funding you are eligible for.

Invoices will be issued each half term for the amount required for any non-funded hours.

### Snacks/meals:

Healthy snacks will be provided during the morning. Parents will need to provide a packed lunch for children attending for the full day.
