

Community Plan Group

Community Plan volunteers meet 3 or 4 times a year to plan Action Days to help improve the 'Look and Feel' of the Parish and to see how they can support activities to bring the community together. Over the past 6 months, Group volunteers have organised two 'Drop & Go' foodbank weekend collections, planted 1,000 more English Bluebells in Glamis Wood, hosted a guided walk, held a litter pick and supported Hall events.



2023 was brought in with a sunny guided walk, with 75 walkers of all ages enjoying exploring the rural footpaths and lanes around the Parish. Afterwards a good many

popped into the Community Coffee morning at the Hall for some light refreshments. The next guided walk will be on the evening of Tuesday 18th July - see page opposite for details.

Thank You to the volunteers who picked up 26 bags of other people's rubbish at the Litter Pick held in February. Thanks also to those kind individual 'Litter Legends' who pick litter on a regular basis keeping the



Churches

As well as weekly services (check out church notice boards for times) St. Helens C of E Church, Rixton Methodist, and Glazebrook Methodist all host

Rixton Methodist is home to Tots on Thursdays 9.30 - 11.30am, term-time only - cost £2 for parent/carer and child with £1 for any further children. 'Time to Talk ' for parents/carers is also offered at the same time - £1.50 (includes a brew and toast). Chapel Crafts is held on the second Tuesday (7.30pm) and the last afternoon (1.30pm) each month. A Coffee Morning is held on the third Saturday of each month 10am - 11.30am. All welcome.

Glazebrook Methodist holds the following: a Coffee morning on the 1st Saturday of each month 10am-12noon; Dance Rhythm's dance and exercise classes weekly on Tuesday evenings for youngsters and adults. Scottish Country Dancing every Wednesday evening.

Message from Rixton-with-Glazebrook Parish Council (PC) Chair - Maureen Banner

"Parish Council members are pleased to welcome Keith Whittam as a new PC Councillor, replacing Cllr Joshua Dixon. Keith lives locally and is an active member of the community having a particular interest in the environment.

The PC continues to keep a keen eye on planning applications, objecting to any we believe are not in keeping with Green Belt policy and village interests. Parish problems are discussed at each meeting and our clerk Nick continues his good work contacting WBC officers to resolve outstanding issues.

Since January 2023, PC community donations have included: match funding for new, more robust, stand-alone junior goal posts for the recreation ground, thanks to successful part funding by the Police; funding to the Hall committee towards flags, bunting and balloons to decorate the hall for the Coronation weekend; and a donation to the Carnival committee for this year's event.

Our Chairman's 'Celebration of Volunteering within the community', in the Spring, was attended by members of the churches and several community groups and was a great success. Councillor McLachlan thanked all who were present for their tireless work, kindness and community spirit and for going the extra mile.
