The committee continues to improve Hall facilities. The small room (baby weighing room many years ago!) has been refurbished into a comfortable, welcoming space for one-to-one meetings. WBC funding enabled the purchase of an impressive chain toaster and commercial dishwasher which has been a huge help with Community Coffee!

Community Plan Group

Community Plan volunteers meet 3-4 times a year to plan Action Days to improve the 'Look and Feel' of the Parish. Since December group volunteers have organised: a 'Drop & Go' foodbank appeal (600 items donated); a guided walk; litter pick ; and road sign cleaning.

In January 14 walkers enjoyed being guided around our lovely rural Parish footpaths, despite the wet weather, and were warmed by some refreshments afterwards at the Community Coffee morning.



In February, 8 volunteers collected 36 bags of litter and some rubble. Thank you to individuals who also kindly pick up litter on a regular basis, together we help to keep the Parish looking cared for. The next Group litter pick is Sun 22nd June - meet Black Swan car park 10am. Litter picks and hi-vis provided, bring your own gloves.

Extra hands are always needed so please come along.

The village sign cleaning action day, involved quite a bit of cutting back overgrowth before cleaning, but this did not deter the 6 eager volunteers who spent a June morning getting stuck in. This is the third signage cleaning the group have done and we can proudly say we have the cleanest and most visible road signs for many a mile!

Friends of Glazebrook Station (FRoGS)

The Friends continue to go from strength to strength winning the award from the Cheshire Best Kept Railway Stations for Halton and Warrington for the 2nd successive year and being commended in two categories of the national Community Rail Network awards. The orchard area is coming along nicely and replenished platform planters and hanging baskets will really brighten up the area through the Summer and Autumn months. Unfortunately, there has been some fly tipping and theft of trellis fencing. Being funded by grants and donations this really has a big impact on the Friends funds! Restoration of the historic drinking fountain dating back to 1872 is due to start this month thanks to funding arranged by Phil Eastty from Warrington Borough Council and the Railway Heritage Trust.

There's always work to be completed and the Friends are particularly looking for green fingered volunteers to help them transform the garden areas and any donations of plants are most welcome! Message from Rixton-with-Glazebrook Parish Council (PC)

While the Parish Council may not always grab headlines, much of the work it does is about quietly getting things done in the background - supporting our community, responding to concerns, and keeping the parish running smoothly. None of what we do would be possible without the time and commitment of my fellow Councillors and I'd like to thank them all for their continued efforts.

The PC continues to deal with various issues within the community from planning applications, potholes, to fly tipping. I would like to thank everyone for continuing to raise issues. Also, a big thank you to all of the hardworking community groups.

The path next to the village recreation ground in Hollins Green was problematic due to it flooding, becoming muddy and dangerous. This has now been resolved with the installation of a new tarmacked area funded by the PC and this area is now much improved. Playground equipment had unfortunately been damaged by a dog. This has now been repaired, painted and the area cleaned.

Following a report on trees on Glazebrook village green, which the PC is responsible for, a programme of maintenance was agreed. Unfortunately, two trees had to be removed and we plan to plant a new tree."


