Rixton-with-Glazebrook Community Hall



The Hall, after its wonderful facelift, is now looking most inviting by day and by night. If you've not had chance to take a look inside yet, then below is a taster of the improvements made. To take a closer

look why not pop

down to the popular Community Coffee Morning held every Monday morning 10.30am - 12.30pm.

As well as the visible improvements to the Hall that include new toilets, kitchen and bar area refit, new lighting, new flooring to foyer and hall, and new electric curtains to the stage, the Hall has also undergone many hidden improvements. These include a new roof, a new heating system,





and a complete electrical rewire. Landscaping and lighting to the front of the building, as well as revised disabled access and drop off area, ensure that all visitors feel welcome.

It's lovely to see the Hall open and looking busy once again. Several of the former weekly social and recreational activities, as well as meetings have now resumed. Bookings for new regular

activities and events are looking healthy and bring some new blood to the Parish - see opposite for 'What's on at the Hall' currently.

Voluntary input by Hall committee members has been invaluable, not only to the refurbishment project, but also to getting the booking system up and running and organising the various management tasks. One aspect they could do with help with is the maintenance of the planted areas to help keep this looking tidy and attractive.

As well as weekly services (check out church notice boards for times) St. Helens C of E Church, Rixton Methodist, and Glazebrook Methodist all host weddings, christenings, funerals, coffee mornings

Rixton Methodist is home to Tots on Thursdays 9.30 - 11.30am, term-time only - cost £2 for parent/carer and child with £1 for any further children. 'Time to Talk ' for parents/carers is also offered at the same time - £1.50 (includes a brew and toast). Chapel Crafts is held on the second Tuesday (7.30pm) and the last afternoon (1.30pm) each month. A Coffee Morning is held on the third Saturday of each month 10am - 11.30am. All welcome.
